

FIVE SIGNS YOU NEED A BALANCE TRANSFER

One of the best ways to get the most from your money is to NOT pay too much in interest charges. But if you're carrying balances on credit cards that charge anywhere from 15 – 29% interest, you're paying way too much interest!

Here are five signs that indicate YOU need to make the switch.

- 1. If you're carrying balances on multiple credit cards, consolidate them into one low-interest account. You can reduce the total amount of interest you'll pay.
- 2. If you have a large balance on a credit card with a high APR, you're paying way too much on interest alone and not much going to pay down your balance. A balance transfer helps you pay down your debt faster.
- 3. If you want to improve your credit utilization, your balance transfer card may offer a higher credit limit, which increases your total available credit.

This is important because credit utilization plays a key role in the FICO credit scoring models. So: Lower interest rate ... Pay down debt faster ... Boosts available credit ... AND improves your credit utilization ratio.

4. If you're paying off a large purchase (appliance, etc.) over time, take advantage of a "Limited time, low interest special offer." Transferring your debt to such a card helps you incur minimal interest.

Calculate how much you'll need to pay each month to clear your debt during the special low interest intro period (3, 6, 12 months).

5. If you're unhappy with the terms / rewards of your current card(s), make the move! While it's not ideal to carry a balance on a credit card (because it costs you money), look for one that offers FREE balance transfers, no annual fee, no cash advance fee.

(That's right ... a low interest rate VISA card from TCCU)

TAX TIME IS ALSO FRAUD TIME

While fraudsters work year-round to scam people out of their money and personal information, tax time can be especially lucrative for them. They use your personal and account information (which they've stolen) to file fraudulent tax returns in your name.

They often report inflated income to increase the size of the return, which they then make off with. Or they pretend to be from the IRS and demand personal information or payment of "owed taxes."

Be aware of these warning signs:

- You receive a (genuine) letter from the IRS saying multiple returns have been filed in your name
- If you receive unfamiliar tax documents like a W-2 or 1099
- Notification of an unfamiliar IRS.gov account
- You receive unsolicited tax transcripts
- Your bank / credit union blocks your tax refund check
- You receive a refund check BEFORE you've filed your taxes
- Your tax preparer refuses to sign your tax return due to discrepancies.

What you should do:

- If you receive a letter from the IRS re: your tax refund, follow the steps detailed in the letter
- If you discover the fraud, immediately contact the IRS and follow their instructions
- If you've sent money to a fake "IRS agent" or tax preparer, contact your financial institution immediately
- If you've given your bank / credit union and account information, contact their fraud department IMMEDIATELY.
